Railroad update from Rail Transit Commission WATCO (new line) taken over CN old lines have a lot of issues they are dealing with lines need major work (in Fox Valley area) been busy trying to build traffic on the lines (contacting shippers, etc.) identified three segments that could eventually be open again: Park Falls to Mellen, Prentice to Tony, Rhinelander to Goodman these lines have the least amount of issues and best opportunity to build business on them. Long-term outlook but may see more rail in the future.

- Dale H. Price County sold the fairgrounds to a developer going to add a campground.
